Planned Actions: Continue to work on hazard tree reduction with heavy equipment so that roads can fully reopen.									
Continue to utilize ground resources to conduct direct containment line on the northeast, south and east sides of the fire. Utilizing a Type 3 helicopter for aerial recon missions to monitor uncontained areas due to remoteness and inaccessibility.									
Continue to mop-up, cold trail, and monitor for any hot spots to continue to work towards containment. Work on suppression repair in identified areas.									
Rain, moisture, and conditions continue to moderate fuel conditions and behavior.
