Non-Voting Task Force Member Roles	 Task Force Chair will approve the final agenda for each Task Force meeting, facilitate each meeting and approve the final meeting notes before publishing. Vice-Chair will coordinate the Task Force Agenda and send it to the Chair for final approval. MNICS Public Information Officer will report to the Task Force and coordinate administrative duties as assigned, including notes. The Center Manager will continue to participate in the Task Force Meetings, because of their role with the border agreement and coordination, but will no longer facilitate the meetings. The Center Manager will serve as a Working Team Representative. Lisa Foust (Forest Service) is now coordinating the MNICS Agreements and will be asked to provide quarterly updates to the Task Force. Task Force Chair Representative – 2021/2022 HSEM is listed on the rotation schedule to serve as the next chair. Task Force discussed reassigning the Task Force Chair to the MN DNR due to
	 the agency's significant connection to Wildfire Management. Task Force will request approval from the MNICS Board of Directors (BOD) to assign the next chair rotation to the Minnesota DNR Task Force Member.
	Working Team Representatives
MNICS Working Teams	 All Working Teams have vital roles to fill for the MNICS organization. The Task Force recognizes some teams have shortages, and agencies are working to fill these shortfalls with new hire trainees. Task Force will seek approval from the Board of Directors to add the requirement that MNICS partnering agencies will serve as the Working Team Chairs.
	 Non-voting organizations that have sat as past Working Team Chairs include the State Patrol and Department of Public Safety, and the Nature Conservancy. Working teams Chairs will maintain a roster of committee members and update their rosters annually to the MNICS Website. Smoke Chasers are considered ad hoc members to working teams, and can be assigned tasks but will not serve as working team chairs.
