Location: Township 151 North – Range 38 West and Township 152

North - Range 38 West; 20 miles west of Red Lake, MN.

Current Status: Over the past two days firefighters and equipment have made very good progress working to secure the fire edge and cool down pockets of heat as necessary around the perimeter of the fire. Most of this work has been done by tracked vehicles with water tanks and firefighters on the ground and support from helicopter Infrared flights. The fire is currently 100 % contained and control of the fire and assigned resources was returned to the local unit at the end of shift last night on 5/6/21. MNICS Team B will be demobilized and returning to their home units today. Team B would like to thank everyone involved for their support and success working to contain the Goods Fire.
