The MNICS Taskforce is accepting applications for the 2022 MNICS Type 3 Incident Management Teams. These Teams will respond to wildfire and all-hazard challenges in Minnesota throughout the year.

Participating as a member of a Type 3 Incident Management Team (IMT) offers the opportunity to become involved with incident management from the ground level. Our teams emphasize professional interactions between team members, cooperators, and stakeholders, which is critical during emergency incident situations. We are looking for leaders who can build a strong team, create solid cohesion, and use an inclusive approach to lead and mentor.

Incident Management Team Season: The team's general availability season is April 1st – June 15th and August 15th – October 31st. The MNICS Taskforce may adjust the season based on fire conditions.

Incident Management Team Term: All selected IMT members will serve one year, and are required to reapply on an annual basis.

Positions: The MNICS Taskforce strongly encourages all applicants – qualified and trainee – to apply. All applicants applying to a primary position who are not selected for a specific team will be placed in the alternate pool.

Qualified Applicants: All qualified applicants will be considered. Qualifications must be current at the time of team selections.

Trainee Applicants: Trainees with a current open task book may apply for positions. Trainees will be selected based on MNICS position needs and interagency priorities.

Alternate and Discretionary Applicants: Alternate and discretionary team members are encouraged to apply for positions listed on the recruitment application.

How to Apply: All applicants must apply using the 2022 MNICS Type 3 IMT Application to be considered.

Selected team members will be notified by email prior to February 1, 2022.
