



2022 MNICS Type II IA Crew Program Application

PLEASE READ THIS BEFORE PROCEEDING

Use this form to submit a 2022 MNICS Type II IA Crew Program application. This application will be used to determine the leadership rosters for the 2022 fire season.

Supervisor approval is required and your IQCS/IQS master record may be requested during the vetting and rostering process. Your application submission indicates that you are currently qualified or have appropriate trainee status for the position you list in this application. The following positions are open to all applicants for the 2022 crews.

Crew Boss (CRWB)
Crew Boss (CRWB) Trainee
Incident Commander Type 5 (ICT5)
Incident Commander Type 5 (ICT5) Trainee Intermediate Faller (FAL2)
Intermediate Faller (FAL2) Trainee

You will need the following items in order to complete your application:

- Current Red Card
- Current Supervisors name, email and phone number
- Past fire experience

Incident Commander Type 5 and Firefighter Type 1 is a combined position taskbook. For those applying in the "squad boss" role please make sure the ICT5 appears on your red card. Type II IA Crews will roster the Incident Commander Type 5 position not the FFT1 position.

Smokechasers submitting an application must be a sponsored AD in order to mobilize out of state with a crew. If you are not sure what your status is, please contact your home unit to confirm your sponsorship or apply to be an AD.

Applicant Information

Last Name: Enter last name as it appears on your ID.

First Name, Middle Name/Middle Initial: Enter first name and middle name/middle initial as it appears on your ID.

Applicant Email Address: If entering more than one email address, please separate them by a comma.

Cell Phone: Enter applicant cell phone number.

Work Phone or Alternate Contact Number: Enter applicant work phone or other phone number.

Select applicant agency. Select and complete "Other" if agency is not listed.

Home Unit: Enter home unit name or host unit name. (Example: Minnesota Agency or Kawishiwi Ranger District)

Home Unit City: Enter city of home unit or host unit.

Select the correct information for each position you are applying

Crew Boss (CRWB) Application: Do you wish to apply for this position as either a qualified or trainee CRWB?

Crew Boss (CRWB): Select if you are a trainee or qualified CRWB and primary or alternate.

Incident Commander Type 5 (ICT5): Do you wish to apply for this position as either a qualified or trainee ICT5?

Incident Commander Type 5 (ICT5): Select if you are a trainee or qualified ICT5 and primary or alternate.

Intermediate Faller (FAL2): Do you wish to apply for this position as either a qualified or trainee FAL2?

Intermediate Faller (FAL2): Select if you are a trainee or qualified FAL2 and if you prefer to be primary or alternate.

Position Preference

For those applying for more than one position what is your preferred position and role? If you are only applying for one position, choose "Does not apply"

Additional Applicant Information

Employment Type: Select applicant employment type, or add new if not listed. Smokechasers must be a sponsored AD in order to mobilized out of state with the crew. If you are not sure what your status is please contact your home unit.

How many seasons of wildland fire experience do you have?: Enter the number of seasons you have been employed as a wildland firefighter or have performed wildland firefighter duties.

Crew Boss (CRWB) Experience: Enter how many times have you served as CRWB or CRWB trainee on any type of handcrew? If none enter 0.

Incident Commander (ICT5) Experience: Enter how many times have you served as ICT5 or ICT5 trainee on any type of handcrew? If none enter 0.

Intermediate Faller (FAL2) Experience: Enter how many times have you served as FAL2 or FAL2 trainee on any type of handcrew? If none enter 0.

Fire Handcrew Experience - Local / In-State? Have you been mobilized locally or in-state on any type of wildland fire handcrew?

Fire Handcrew Experience - Out of State?: Have you been mobilized out of state on any type of wildland fire handcrew?

Medical Support Qualifications: Are you qualified for any of the following? Select the appropriate role and if it is on your red card. Choose None if you don't have any of these. If you have other medical skills describe this in the other block.
