IROC Reports Class size: 16 Wednesday June 12, 2024

Do you want to learn how to access the vast amount of data in IROC, but don't know where to start? This class will provide students with skills to use the existing IROC Reporting and spreadsheets. Hands on demonstrations and exercises will help students navigate existing IROC reports and effectively use IROC Data Management Tool (DMT) data. When we have finished reviewing the basics we will look at modifying existing reports and building reports from scratch. Students must have an active IROC user account.
