The MNICS Taskforce is accepting applications for the 2025 MNICS Type 3 Incident Management Teams. Our interagency teams respond to wildfire and all-hazard challenges in Minnesota throughout the year.

Participating as a member of a Type 3 Incident Management Team (IMT) you'll have the opportunity to become involved with incident management from the ground level. Our teams emphasize professional interactions between team members, cooperators, and stakeholders, which is critical during emergency incident situations. We are looking for leaders to build a strong team, create solid cohesion, and use an inclusive approach to lead and mentor.

The MNICS team's local availability is split between spring and fall. The spring availability runs from April 1 – June 15, and the fall availability runs from September 1 – October 31. The MNICS Taskforce may adjust local availability based on in-state fire conditions.

For the past 2 years, we have been able to roster and mobilize a MNICS Type 3 IMT nationally. Type 3 incident support remains critical to overall incident management success as the national need for experienced teams continues to grow. MNICS will continue to support national availability of the MNICS Type 3 IMTs, from June through August, as we move forward into 2025. The MNICS Task Force, in consultation with the team Incident Commander's, will coordinate national availability to ensure that local needs are being met prior to making an IMT available.

We welcome qualified and trainee applications for any team position. Applicants may apply to both primary and alternate roles. We also encourage qualified and trainee resources to fill discretionary positions that help support the team when there is a need. All selected IMT members will serve a one-year term and must re-apply on an annual basis for consideration.
