Preparedness Levels

Minnesota = 4	Eastern Area = 4	National = 5
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Strategic Intent:

- Continue to support initial attack and emerging incidents.
- Maintain staffing on fires to meet incident objectives.
- Maximize resource allocation opportunities to meet the needs of multiple incidents.

Incident Priorities:

Priority	Incident Name	Unit	Team	Rationale: Protection of life, property and resources
1	Initial Attack & Emerging Incidents	-	-	-
2	Camp	SUF	CIMT - SA 1	Complex terrain and logistics. Difficult access. Evacuations in effect. BWCA closures. Significant economic impacts. Limit spread toward Winton and Ely.
3	Sioux	SUF	CIMT - SA 1	Dispersed structures and communications infrastructure. Difficult access. Evacuations in effect. BWCA closures. Securing S. perimeter slopover. Keep fire N of Echo Tr.
4	Bear Trap	SUF	CIMT - SA 1	Complex terrain and logistics. Difficult access. Evacuations in effect. BWCA closures. Int'l coordination. Obj: Slow progression toward Echo Tr., protect structures in Big Lake and surrounding properties.
5	Chub	SUF	CIMT - SA 1	Min Bx. No growth on all fires. Chub 95% contained, 493 is 51%. All others are 100%. Continue to secure, mop-up and patrol. Chub, 344.6 ac, + others combined total 424 ac. Some evacs lifted. IA/holdover threats remain.
6	Thumb	SUF	CIMT - SA 1	Int'l coordination. Complex terrain and logistics. Evacuations in effect. BWCA closures. Spread in Canada past 5-mi reciprocal response likely, closely monitored. Crew working N. flank to secure Canada spread.
7	Little Knife	SUF	NIMO 3	Min Fire Bx. Int'l coordination. Complex terrain and logistics. Evacuations in effect. BWCA closures. Developing long-term strategy. Obj: protect dispersed historic structures and wilderness values. Line resources arriving. Tentative TOC to NIMO 1 7/27 1600.
8	Long Lake	2NS	CIMT - SA1	Disc. 7/19. Good progress continues.
